A CLEANER LADYWOOD:

- Bring back **FREE bulky waste** collections (x2 a year)
- **Restore** street cleaning - Labour want to SLASH this by £1.5million
- **Prosecute** landlords who allow waste to be dumped on roadsides

A GREENER LADYWOOD

- Tackle **fly-tipping** via local budgets and ensure that fly-tippers are **prosecuted**
- Slash annual charge for the green waste to just **£10** in 2019, then **FREE in 2020**
- Support more **parking permit schemes** and work to improve and increase cycle routes



A SAFER LADYWOOD

- Create new networks with **community groups**, police, schools & faith groups
- Work to **introduce PCSOs**, with more powers, into areas that are lacking
- Get the council to **support the Police**, in finding local bases for their teams
